ZAMEK Culture Centre in Poznań is one of the largest cultural institutions in the country. Each year, the institution hosts 2,500 events which both showcase and stimulate the development of the most interesting phenomena in culture. The spaces and interiors of ZAMEK are a venue where one sees the interfacing and mutually complementary presence of visual arts, theater, film, music and literature. The programme relies both on the tried and tested forms of expression (e.g. concerts, performances, exhibitions, soirees and literary meetings, film screenings) as well as on experimental artistic undertakings by embarking on new types of activities, often site-specific ones. These ventures are much aided by ZAMEK's artist-in-residence programme. The Centre for Educational Practices, which functions as part of the institution, aims to develop and implement new methods and tools of education, as well as initiates and supports collaboration between the domains of culture and school education. Our activities would not be what they are if not for the social context of ZAMEK's activities, therefore much emphasis is placed on collaboration with the institution's immediate surroundings. Also, we develop a programme of urban education which, among other things, encompasses debates about the problems of the local community, workshops, or animation projects in St. Martin street. In fact, the programme is a singular handbook on how to use and take advantage of the city. Given the fact that the institution resides in a former imperial castle, an extraordinary witness of 20th-century European history, the reflection on history and its impact on the present day are also an eminent item on our agenda.

Poznan Heritage Centre is a municipal cultural institution which tells the story of Poznań and its heritage. We do it at **Porta Posnania**, at the **Enigma Cipher Centre**, the **Śluza Gallery**, at the Royal-Imperial Route and Fest Fyrtel. We also run various projects such as the Śródka Community Archive and the Poznań Legends Route for Children.

The Enigma Cipher Centre tells the unknown story of the success of Polish mathematicians. It popularizes the story and places it in the history of ciphers and international technological change. The Centre runs educational, cultural



and scientific workshops which inspire social activity in the city centre. The Enigma Cipher Centre is a brand of Poznań Heritage Centre – a municipal cultural institution. In line with our motto 'True history. Challenge for the mind', we use an innovative, multimedia exhibition to tell the story of the breaking of the code of the German cipher machine Enigma by Polish cryptologists: Marian Rejewski, Henryk Zygalski and Jerzy Różycki. We want to unceasingly promote and popularize this unknown story because the contribution of the Polish mathematicians to the victory of the allies during the Second World War is still little known or even forgotten. The Enigma Cipher Centre is the second institution in Poznań, after Porta Posnania, whose activity is rooted in heritage interpretation. We are inspired by the fact that the exhibition devoted to the Poznań cryptologists is located in the exact spot where during the interwar period stood the building of the Poznań branch of the Cipher Bureau, which employed Rejewski, Zygalski and Różycki. By presenting the story of the victory of the human mind over a machine which the Nazi used to conquer the world, we educate and promote the Centre's values such as open-mindedness, teamwork, joint effort, courage and persistence in pursuing even the most difficult goals. The Enigma Cipher Centre not only pays tribute to the outstanding Polish cryptologists but it also presents the history of encoding messages over the centuries and of the development of computers and computer science, which are the result of the work on deciphering enemy messages during the Second World War. This fascinating tale is told with the use of multimedia and scenography as well as keepsakes from the lives of the cryptologists.

Porta Posnania is an interactive centre for the history of Cathedral Island. Its main attraction is a multimedia exhibition telling the story of the Cathedral Island, the beginnings of Poland and the history of Poznań. Visitors explore the story of the Cathedral Island with an audio guide available in 8 language versions. The visit consists of two stages: first, you are invited to explore our unique exhibition located in Porta Posnania's minimalist building; then we encourage you to take a walk around the Cathedral Island and see the Cathedral itself. We offer two trails to choose from: for adults and young people, and for families with children. We also frequently run thematic guided tours and workshops. Porta Posnania is the first heritage interpretation centre in Poland. It also offers a wonderful space by the Cybina River where everyone is welcome to meet with their friends, relax and catch a breath.
